

## Press Release Lake Michigan Water Project Begins Construction

Lake Villa, IL. Village Officials are announcing that construction has begun on the first of two projects that will bring Lake Michigan water to the Village of Lake Villa and the Fox Lake Hills subdivision in unincorporated Lake County. The Central Lake County Joint Action Water Agency (CLCJAWA) recently awarded an agreement with the low bidder, Trine Construction for the construction of a water main from the Village of Lake Villa water delivery structure to the Lake County delivery structure in the Fox Lake Hills subdivision. The water main will run the length of Cedar Lake Road from Monaville Road to the Village of Lake Villa water delivery structure and from Monaville Road west to the Fox Lake Hills subdivision.

The majority of the work will be outside of the roadway area, however, at times, there may be traffic disruptions that cause one lane on Monaville Road or Cedar Lake Road to be temporarily closed. The project is scheduled to be substantially completed by September, 2018.

The second project includes the installation of a water main from Hook Drive in Round Lake Beach to the Monaville and Cedar Lake Road intersection. It will run the length of Route 83 to Monaville Road and will terminate at Cedar Lake Road. This contract has been awarded to the low bidder, Joel Kennedy Construction, with an anticipated beginning construction date of February, 2018 and a substantial completion date of February, 2019.

Once both of these projects are complete, the Village of Lake Villa and Fox Lake Hills will be served with Lake Michigan water.
