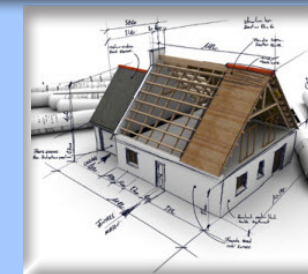

A MESSAGE FROM THE MAYOR

Dear Resident,

Currently, the Village is making plans for capital improvements around the Village. These projects either maintain our existing infrastructure or enhances public infrastructure to enhance Lake Villa. Here are some examples of these projects:

-Road Resurfacing (Oakland Ridge Subdivision): This project includes resurfacing the roads throughout the subdivision and repairing damaged storm-sewers and curbs. The alley behind Walgreens will also be resurfaced.

-Sidewalk Repairs: Annually, the Village inspects all sidewalks and categorizes them for repair. The sidewalks are rated by the severity of the repairs needed.

-Road Patching: Annually, the Village inspects all roads and repairs hazardous areas.

-Downtown Improvements: The Village received a \$200,000 Community Development Block Grant to improve Cedar Avenue. These improvement opportunities include: streetscaping, beautification, landscapings, replacing sidewalks and lighting, and resurfacing parking lots. The Village is contributing funds for our local share. Additional information will be released as the project nears so we can minimize the construction impact.

-Pedestrian Improvements: The Village received a 100% funded federal grant to install new sidewalks on Central Avenue, Lake Avenue, and Cedar Avenue. Due to the large amount of paperwork required with a federal grant, this project is slated for 2017.

The Village is gradually making changes to improve the quality of life for residents. These projects represent efforts underway to strengthen our public infrastructure. We look forward to more opportunities to grow Lake Villa.

SEWER CLEANING

The Village will pick up leaves for two weeks beginning April 15th. Please do not rake branches, sticks, grass clippings, etc... into the leaf piles as these items cause the hose to get clogged and even damaged.

PROPERTY MAINTENANCE

This is a friendly reminder that maintaining the appearance of your home in conformance with the Village Code helps to keep property values high and makes Lake Villa a more desirable place to live and work. Examples of violations include junk and debris, chipping paint, overgrown plants and shrubs, and inoperable vehicles.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Yard waste is collected weekly beginning April 15 through November 30. Residents may sign up for seasonal service or use yard waste stickers. Seasonal service may be set up by calling Waste Management Customer Service at (800) 796-9696. Stickers can be purchased at: 305 E Grand Ave, Lake Villa. Yard waste must be placed in biodegradable Kraft paper bags or marked cans (max 33 gallons and 45 pounds) for collection. Yard waste placed in plastic bags will not be collected.

HYDRANT FLUSHING

The Village performs the hydrant flushing program during the night in mid to late April. Signs will be posted as a reminder. You may experience rusty water or a temporary change of water pressure during this process. If you notice rust in the water, let your water run a few minutes until it clears. Avoid doing laundry when rust is visible in the water.

SUMMER SEWER RATES

With summer approaching, many homeowners are sprucing up their yards and gardens and using water outside. Keep in mind that summer sewer rates go into effect May 15th to September 15th. During this time, your maximum sewer usage will be 110% of your winter average usage since some of your water does not go into the sewer system.
