Lake Villa, IL. The Village of Lake Villa is asking residents to take preventative steps to help limit the spread of the coronavirus. The coronavirus is primarily spread via person to person contact and the Village of Lake Villa is urging residents, as much as possible, to perform Village functions online, via the telephone or by mail.

While the Village Hall and Police Department will remain normal business hours, the Village is asking residents to help limit the spread of the coronavirus by:

- Using the Village's online payment system or lockbox mailing system for all utility bill payments. Utility billing payment options can be located at www.lake-villa.org. If these options do not work for you, please place all payments in the drop box at the front of the Village Hall during non-business hours.
- Using the Village's online building registration program for fences, roof replacement, window replacement and other residential permits. If your project requires a permit, the Village can mail you a building permit application by calling 847-356-6100. Please submit the building permit in the drop box or via the mail to P.O. Box 519, Lake Villa, Illinois 60046.

Again, the Village Hall and Police Department will remain open during normal business hours.
