## GENERAL INFORMATION

### SPRING SEASON IS APPROACHING - REMEMBER TO BE A GOOD NEIGHBOR

Residents take pride in their properties and neighborhoods and often contact Village Staff with concerns about issues they feel impact the character and appearance of the community - Here are some helpful reminders we can all take to be a good neighbor:

- **Maintain landscaping & weeds** - Grass/lawns should not exceed 8 inches in height. Please keep your shrubbery and trees in good health and condition, especially when it encroaches over public sidewalks.
- **Ensure vehicles are operable and parked** - Vehicles, including recreation vehicles, boats and trailers, should be parked on hard surfaces (pavement, concrete, etc.) at all times. They should be operable (no flat tires) and properly licensed.
- **Garbage and outdoor storage** - Garbage must be disposed of in an approved covered container and can only be placed at the curb on scheduled pickup days. If you are storing materials outdoors, ensure they are stored in enclosed containers or completely covered.
- **Accumulation of Rubbish** - Properties shall be kept clean and clear of accumulation of trash, junk, partially dismantled motor vehicles, wrecked motor vehicles, discarded appliances, furniture, or other similar items and materials.
- **Keep structures and property in good conditions** - All buildings, exteriors, and accessory structures, including windows, doors, sheds, fences, garages, pools, siding, etc. must be kept in good and safe repair. Rental inspections are required prior to a tenant moving into a rental property.
- **Keep swimming pools clean and in good repair** - All swimming pools are required to be maintained in a clean and sanitary condition, and in good repair.
- **Follow construction hours carefully** - Ensure construction activity on your property is limited to 7am - 8pm Monday- Friday, or 8am - 8pm on Saturdays, and 9am - 8pm on Sundays.
- **Signs, signs, everywhere signs** - Signs are not permitted on Village right-of-ways (generally the area between your sidewalk or driveway apron and the roadway). Garage sale signs, election signs, or for sale/for rent signs, community event, or sporting club signs are allowed on private property. Garage sale signs may be posted for no more than 3 consecutive days and must be removed at the end of the event.
- **Keep lights turned down low** - Outdoor lights shall not illuminate onto adjacent property owned by another person. Please make sure your outdoor lights, including any flood lights, are pointed downward so as not to spill onto adjacent yards.

If concerns arise, talk with your neighbor! Your neighbor may not realize that a condition on their property is causing a concern. Communication and consideration are key. For more information you may contact the Village at 847-356-6100.

### IMPORTANT INFO ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Our water system has been sampled for a series of unregulated contaminants. Unregulated contaminants are those that don't yet have a drinking water standard set by the EPA. The purpose of monitoring for these contaminants is to help the EPA decide whether the contaminants should have a standard. As our customers, you have a right to know that this data is available. ### HYDRANT FLUSHING

The Village performs hydrant flushing in mid to late April. Signs will be posted as a reminder. You may experience rusty water or a temporary change of the water pressure during this process. If you notice rust in the water, let your water run for a few minutes until it clears. Avoid doing laundry when rust is visible in the water.

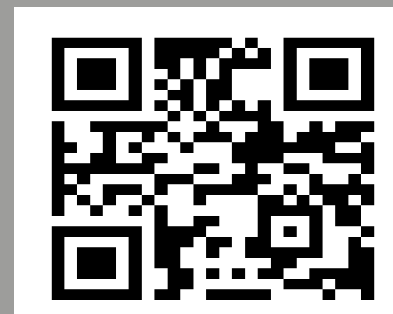
### LEAD SERVICE LINE IDENTIFICATION INITIATIVE & SURVEY

Recently, the Federal Government mandated that municipalities must find out where lead services are located throughout the community to begin the process of eliminating them. Lead, unlike other drinking water contaminants, is usually not present in the drinking water source. It results from the distribution system or on-site plumbing itself. Lead gets into water at the tap when water corrodes lead in pipes, fixtures, and solder. The most impactful way to reduce the risk of exposure to lead in drinking water is to remove the lead service line that brings water to your home from the water main.

To find out if you have a copper, lead, or galvanized steel service on your property, you can perform a test on the water service line where it connects to the water meter to determine the material of the water service line on your property.

The Village of Lake Villa is surveying all homes to identify existing lead service lines. Please complete the brief Water Service Line Material survey to determine the material composition of your water lines by using the QR code below.

### NEW WASTE HAULER

We are pleased to inform you that the Village has signed a contract with LRS as our new waste, recycling, and landscape hauler beginning May 1, 2024. As part of the new service, residents will receive new garbage and recycling carts. Residents will continue to have weekly garbage and recycling service and 1 bulk item per week. Extra trash will require one sticker per bag. Stickers will be available for sale at the same retailers (Village Hall & Jewel Osco in Round Lake Beach).

Service days throughout the community will remain the same throughout the month of May. **Effective 6/1 all homes in the Village of Lake Villa will be switching to a Friday service day. The entire Village of Lake Villa's first Friday service will be 6/7. Please note, service times are subject to change.**

In the near future, you can expect the following communications via USPS regarding the transition process:

- Early March, residents should have received a postcard that explained how to select your cart size. If no selection was made, the resident will receive the same size cart currently being used by Waste Management.
- In mid-March, residents should have received a more detailed mailer from LRS in the form of a brochure going into detail regarding waste, recycling, landscape waste, organics, and the Leaf Vacuum program.
