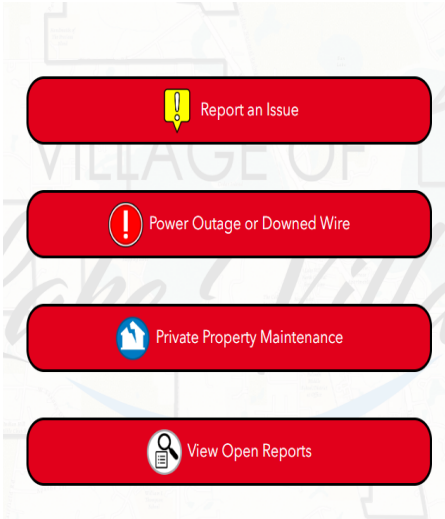


NEW CITIZEN REQUEST PORTAL

GENERAL INFORMATION



MAILBOX REPAIRS NEED TO BE COMPLETED BEFORE PLOW SEASON

Public Works needs your help! Make sure your mailbox is sturdy and ready for the upcoming snow season. Please take some time and check the condition and proper placement of your mailbox. If the post is rotted or broken, please repair or replace it before the weather changes.

Here are some helpful guidelines to follow when placing your mailbox:

- Position your mailbox 41" to 45" from the road surface to the bottom of the mailbox or point of mail entry
- Place your mailbox 6" to 8" back from the curb. If you do not have a raised curb, contact your local postmaster for guidance
- Put your house number on the mailbox

Public Works is only responsible for repairing/replacing mailboxes damaged or hit by our trucks.

SHORT TERM RENTALS

According to Village Code, Ordinance 10-4-5-3, states that the accessory use and or occupancy for a period of less than 3 months of a principal structure or accessory structure is prohibited in the Village of Lake Villa.

OPEN BURNING

Pursuant to Village Ordinance, open burning is prohibited within the corporate limits of the Village. The open burning ban includes leaves, yardwaste, garbage, & tires. Residents conducting an open burn in violation of this ordinance may be ticketed.

WATER METER CHANGEOUT PROGRAM UPDATE

WHAT'S HAPPENING AROUND THE VILLAGE

LEAF VACUUMING

LRS will pick up leaves weekly, starting the end of October for 6 weeks. Residents are asked to rake leaves to the curb by Monday morning, for pickup by LRS. Leaves should be raked in a narrow long line with the back of the pile no further than 4 feet from the mailbox. Leaves will be picked up weekly. Look for updates on the actual start date.

Note: Dates may be adjusted based on weather

BRANCH PICKUP

LRS collects branches on your normal garbage day. Branches must be bundled and tied together in no longer than four foot lengths and should not weigh more than fifty pounds. Each bundle must have an LRS sticker on them.

TRICK OR TREAT

Halloween Trick or Treating hours will be on Thursday, October 31, 2024 from 4pm - 7pm. Here are some safety tips:

1. Stay on Well-Lit Paths by using sidewalks whenever possible. If you must walk on the road, stay to the side.
2. Always Trick-or-Treat in Groups - Set boundaries. Parents should establish clear rules about which streets or neighborhoods are off-limits
3. Inspect Candy Before Eating - Avoid eating homemade treats from unknown sources
4. Watch for Traffic - Remind all to look both ways before crossing the street and use crosswalks whenever possible
5. Respect Your Neighbors- Only visit homes with lights on as it is a sign they're participating in Halloween.
