Frequently asked questions regarding a building permit:

1) Can I start my project before I get the permit?

No. Wait until you actually have the permit in hand. If you are caught working without a permit, you will be charged double for the permit.

2) What hours are you open?

We're open 8:30 am to 4:30 pm Monday through Friday

3) How many plans do I need to submit, and do they have to be stamped and sealed by a license architect?

<u>Residential</u>: We require three (3) sets, and they can be hand drawn as long as the drawing is clear and correct. For outdoor projects, we'll also require a copies of your plat of survey.

<u>Commercial:</u> We require three sets, and it must be stamped by an Illinois licensed architect.

4) Do I need to submit contractor license?

We de require a state license only if the project is electrical, plumbing or roofing.

5) How long does it take to get my building permit approved?

Normally it takes a minimum of ten (10) days for the permit to be approved plus processing time.

6) Do I need an inspection?

Most permits do require at least one inspection. You'll be given a list of what inspections we require along with further instructions when you pay for the permit.

7) Does my project have to start within a certain time?

Yes, your project must begin within 90 days from the date that it is issued.

8) When does the permit expire?

Please refer to <u>Title 8-4-1 #C Amendments</u>, <u>deletions</u>, <u>additions and/or modifications to International Residential Code (IRC) Permit Time Limits</u>, <u>IRC Page 5</u>, <u>Section R105.5</u> (Village Code Building Regulations).

9) Is there anything else I should do for my permit?

Yes, if your project is outdoors. It's required by law that you call J.U.L.I.E to locate all underground utilities in your yard. You can contact them by dialing 811. It's a free service.

10) I have a septic system. Do I have anything special to do for an outside project?

Yes, we cannot approve your permit without having a copy of an ISD (individual sewer disposal) permit from the Lake County Health Department. Contact them at 847-377-8020, or go to 500 Winchester Road in Libertyville for more information.
