FROM THE MAYOR

Dear Reader,

The Village has spent a lot of time and money creating plans that would guide the Village's growth to ensure new developments were built in a way that maximized benefits for Lake Villa. With these plans ready for use and with the economic condition improving, the Village has been exploring ways to bring new commercial development to Lake Villa. In our current economic climate, incentives are necessary on virtually all new projects. The most effective economic incentive is a Tax Increment Financing (TIF) District. A TIF District allocates the incremental increase in property taxes from a designated area as an economic incentive tool. All taxing bodies continue to receive the same amount of property taxes that are being generated when the TIF is created. Most commercial areas in the proposed area are underdeveloped or undeveloped and, without the use of a TIF District, it is unlikely that new commercial development will occur for some time.

TIF Districts can be used to construct public improvement, rehabilitate buildings, and site improvements. In Illinois, these districts can exist for up to 23 years. The Village's proposed TIF District would be in and around the Village's downtown commercial area and the northern portion of the industrial area off of Park Avenue and commercial and residential areas around Grand Avenue and Route 83.


The process to establish a TIF District is a nine month, State regulated, process which should conclude in August of 2016. A map of the proposed TIF District and additional information can be located on the Village's website: www. lake-villa.org/TIF.

Keep in mind that as the plows come by, snow is diverted to the curb off to the right side of the plow. Snow may accumulate in the end of driveway approaches as the plow truck passes by. Please do not shovel this snow back into the street **DELAYED GARBAGE PICK-UP** because snow that is shoveled into the street can freeze and Garbage and recycling are not collected on Thanksgiving Day, cause dangerous conditions. When shoveling your driveway, Christmas Day, or New Year's Day.
