NEW PUBLIC WORKS INFRASTRUCTURE FOR THE VILLAGE OF LAKE VILLA



The Village of Lake Villa is in the process of improving its public works infrastructure including: construction of a new 1.5 million gallon water storage tank, water facilities building improvements, and a water main through the Sun Lake Forest Preserve. The new water storage tank will add to the Village's water storage capacity in the event of a temporary disruption of service. The water facilities building improvements will allow the Village to accept a new water source, Lake Michigan Water, and will enhance the Village's ability to monitor and respond to alarms. The water main through the forest preserve will connect the Village's two water systems. Funding for this project was provided by a low interest loan from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Public Water Supply Loan Program (PWSLP). The PWSLP is funded by both state and federal sources. The \$4,452,372 loan has an interest rate of 1.86% and will be repaid over 20 years. The new tank will meet the recommended water storage standards based on our water usage. For more information contact Village Hall at (847) 356-6100


