WASTE MANAGEMENT CART EXCHANGE PROGRAM

Residents are encouraged to recycle more of their waste and during the month of June each year residents can upgrade from a Waste Management 65-gallon recycling cart (with the yellow lid) to a Waste Management 96-gallon cart at no charge. SUMMER SEWER RATES

With summer approaching, many homeowners are sprucing up their yards and gardens and using water outside. Keep in mind that summer sewer rates go into effect May 15th to September 15th. During this time, your maximum sewer usage will be 110% of your winter average usage since some of your water does not go into the sewer system.

METRA PARKING PROGRAM

Metra riders can pay \$34 for an unlimited monthly parking pass for the Lake Villa Metra Station. Enrolled riders receive a parking hang tag to display in their vehicle. Tags are available at Village Hall.

LAWN SPRINKLER SYSTEMS

The Village of Lake Villa has partnered with BSI Online to assist in administering the backflow prevention program, required by the State of Illinois, to protect the safety of the public water system. All cross-connections between the Village water system and another source must have a backflow prevention assembly installed. Assemblies must be tested and certified every year to ensure that they are working properly. YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Yard waste is collected weekly beginning April 15 through November 30. Residents may sign up for seasonal service or use yard waste stickers. Seasonal service may be set up by calling Waste Management Customer Service at (800) 796-9696. Stickers can be purchased at: 305 E Grand Ave, Lake Villa. Yard waste must be placed in biodegradable Kraft paper bags or marked cans (max 33 gallons and 45 pounds) for collection. Yard waste placed in plastic bags will not be collected.
