A MESSAGE FROM THE MAYOR

Dear Resident:

Plans are in the works to complete many capital improvement projects around the Village. The following enhancements are scheduled for 2018:

Pedestrian Improvements: The Village received a 100% Federal funded grant to install sidewalks on Central, Lake, and Cedar Avenues that will be installed this year.

In a joint effort with Lake County, Lake Villa Township, Community District 117, School District 34 and Village of Lake Villa, the intersection at Deep Lake Road and Grass Lake Road now has pedestrian lights with crosswalks. In 2018, a sidewalk will be constructed from Deep Lake Road to the existing sidewalk by Oakland Ridge subdivision. This project will complete a pedestrian friendly route from the subdivisions of Oakland Ridge and Painted Lakes to Oakland School and Lakes High School.

Sidewalk Repairs: Annually, the Village inspects all sidewalks and categorizes them for repairs. The sidewalks are then prioritized by the severity of the repairs needed.

Street Maintenance: This year's projects include resurfacing the roads throughout the North Shore of Deep Lake Subdivision. Other resurfacing and curb repair include Kevin Avenue, Wesley Avenue and East Burnett Avenue. Annually, the Village inspects all roads, and patches hazardous areas as needed.

Downtown Improvements: The downtown Cedar Avenue improvements that began last year will continue down the street. These improvements include streetscaping, landscaping, sidewalks, and street lighting to enhance the downtown business district.

Lake Michigan Water: Due to the number of easements and construction phases in this project, our anticipated connection to Lake Michigan water should be completed by early 2019.

These projects represent efforts to continue to strengthen our public infrastructure.

HYDRANT FLUSHING

The Village performs the hydrant flushing program during the night in mid to late April. Signs will be posted as a reminder. You may experience rusty water or a temporary change of water pressure during this process. If you notice rust in the water, let your water run a few minutes until it clears. Avoid doing laundry when rust is visible in the water.

SUMMER SEWER RATES

With summer approaching, many homeowners are sprucing up their yards and gardens and using water outside. Keep in mind that summer sewer rates go into effect May 15th to September 15th. During this time, your maximum sewer usage will be 110% of your winter average usage since some of your water does not go into the sewer system.

OPEN BURNING

Pursuant to Village Ordinance, open burning is prohibited within the corporate limits of the Village. The open burning ban includes leaves, yard waste, garbage, and tires. Residents conducting an open burn in violation of this Ordinance may be ticketed.

GENERAL INFORMATION

WATER & SEWER E-BILLING

To receive an electronic bill instead of a paper bill, please call the Village Hall at (847) 356-6100, or send an email to webmaster@lake-villa.org to enroll. When emailing your request, please include your name, account number, and home address.

You can also view your utility bill and account history online at www.lake-villa.org. To access your account, you will need your account number and the Pin number from your bill. While online, you may also pay your utility bill via a credit card. Residents and business owners may also sign up for auto debit to have your bill automatically debited from your account on the due date.

METRA SERVICE

The Village is on the North Central Line with weekday service from Antioch to Chicago. Visit www.metrarail.com for schedules and additional information. To fund the maintenance of the parking facilities and the Metra station, the daily parking fee is \$1.75. The North Central Line, which services Lake Villa, is also an O'Hare Transfer line. You can reach both Chicago and O'Hare on the same train route.
