Dear Resident:

I would like to remind residents of the Police Department's Neighborhood Policing Program. This program is designed to promote a partnership and facilitate communication between the residents and the Police Department. This program gives the citizens a contact within the Department that they can use for non-emergency reasons. Each subdivision is assigned a neighborhood police officer that the resident can contact. You can ask questions, report activity (speeding vehicles, graffiti, extra patrol requests, etc.), give anonymous tips regarding criminal or suspicious behavior, or other general concerns. This program is not meant for in progress or emergency situations. For an in progress situation, please call 9-1-1 for emergency assistance or 847-356-6106 for non-emergency assistance.

You can find the contact information for the officer assigned to your neighborhood by visiting the Police Department Page of the Village website. I hope you find this program helpful.

Pursuant to Village Ordinance, open burning is prohibited within the corporate limits of the Village. The open burning ban includes leaves, yard waste, garbage, and tires. Residents conducting an open burn in violation of this Ordinance may be ticketed.

GENERAL INFORMATION

BRANCH PICKUP

Waste Management will be collecting branches on your normal garbage day. Branches must be bundled and tied together in no longer than four foot lengths and should not weigh more than fifty pounds. An unlimited amount of bundles may be placed at your curb for collection.

WATER QUALITY REPORT

WATERING RESTRICTIONS

The Village has an ordinance in place to help with water conservation. Residents with even numbered addresses may sprinkle on even numbered days from 8pm to 8am and residents with odd addresses may sprinkle on odd numbered days from 8pm to 8am. No watering is allowed on Sundays.

SUMMER SEWER RATES

With summer approaching, many homeowners are sprucing up their yards and gardens and using water outside. Keep in mind that summer sewer rates go into effect May 15th to September 15th. During this time, your maximum sewer usage will be 110% of your winter average usage since some of your water does not go into the sewer system.

PHOSPHORUS FREE FERTILIZERS

The Village prohibits the use of fertilizers that contain phosphorus. Phosphorus causes unwanted biological growth, which can degrade the quality of our lakes and streams. For more information, please visit www.lake-villa.org.

2. Insist to meet at a public place such as a police department lobby.
3. Do not meet in a secluded area.
4. Do not invite strangers into your home, and do not go to theirs.
5. Be cautious when buying/selling high value items.
6. Perform the transaction during daylight hours.
7. If it sounds too good to be true, it normally is.
8. Tell a friend or family member about your intentions.
9. Take your cell phone with you.
