Dear Residents:

Pardon our dust! Plans are in the works to complete many capital improvement projects around the Village. Here are a couple of projects underway:

Downtown Improvements: The downtown Cedar Avenue improvement project is in the final phase this year. The project will include new sidewalks, decorative street lights, landscaping, benches and new signage branding in the business district. It is important to note that the businesses on Cedar Avenue will be open while we spruce up the downtown area.

The purpose of this project is to attract new business as well as make it easier and safer to walk in the downtown area and to the Metra Station.

Pedestrian Improvements: The construction on the Grass Lake Road sidewalk project is in full swing. This project includes installation of a sidewalk heading west on Grass Lake Road from the Deep Lake Road intersection to the Oakland Ridge subdivision.. This is a joint project between Lake County, Lake Villa Township, Community District 117, School District 34 and Village of Lake Villa. This project, anticipated to be completed in July, will provide a pedestrian friendly route from the subdivisions of Oakland Ridge and Panted Lakes to Oakland School and Lakes High School.

These projects represent continued efforts to make Lake Villa more pedestrian friendly.

We hope to see you at Celebration of Summer in Lehmann Park on June 8th for our annual Concert and Fireworks!

CELEBRATION OF SUMMER CONCERT & FIREWORKS

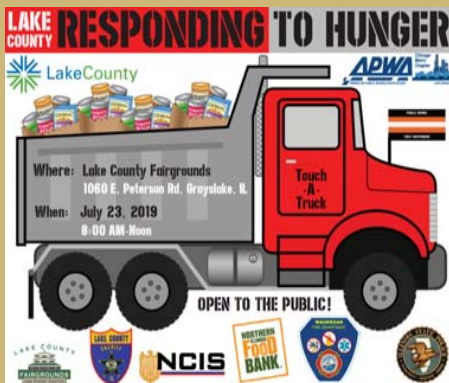

Pursuant to Village Ordinance, open burning is prohibited within the corporate limits of the Village. The open burning ban includes leaves, yard waste, garbage, and tires. Residents conducting an open burn in violation of this Ordinance may be ticketed.

GENERAL INFORMATION

BRANCH PICKUP

Waste Management will be collecting branches on your normal garbage day. Branches must be bundled and tied together in no longer than four foot lengths and should not weigh more than fifty pounds. An unlimited amount of bundles may be placed at your curb for collection.

WATER QUALITY REPORT

WATERING RESTRICTIONS

The Village has an ordinance in place to help with water conservation. Residents with even numbered addresses may sprinkle on even numbered days from 8pm to 8am and residents with odd addresses may sprinkle on odd numbered days from 8pm to 8am. No watering is allowed on Sundays.

SUMMER SEWER RATES

With summer approaching, many homeowners are sprucing up their yards and gardens and using water outside. Keep in mind that summer sewer rates go into effect May 15th to September 15th. During this time, your maximum sewer usage will be 110% of your winter average usage since some of your water does not go into the sewer system.

NEW WATER & SEWER RATES ESTABLISHED

Water & Sewer rates have been adjusted for all bills released after May 1, 2019. The new rates included in the enclosed bill are noted below.

Water rates will increase from \$8.45/1,000 gallons to \$9.04/1,000 gallons. Sewer rates will increase from \$6.58/1,000 gallons to \$7.04/1,000 gallons.
