A MESSAGE FROM THE MAYOR

Dear Resident,

This year, the United States Census Bureau will be completing an important task; counting populations and gathering other demographic data. The data that the Census Department is collecting is important and I encourage you to help them collect this data. Census data is important because it will determine congressional representation, will direct hundreds of billions in federal funding, and will provide data that will impact communities for the next decade.

Over the next decade, lawmakers, business owners, and many others will use 2020 Census data to make critical decisions. The results will show communities that need new schools, new clinics, new roads, and more services for families, older adults, and children.

Census data also matters locally. It determines the amount of funding that Lake Villa will receive from the State of Illinois. The State distributes various funds to municipalities based on their population, as determined by the Census. Making sure you and your family is counted ensures that Lake Villa receives revenue that we are entitled to. This revenue is vital so Lake Villa has sufficient funding to provide basic municipal services.

In Mid-March, the Census Bureau will be sending to your place of residence an invitation to complete. You will be asked to respond to this invitation online, by phone, or by mail. The Census Bureau will continue to follow up with you during the course of the year, including possibly visiting your home. If someone visits your home to collect information for the 2020 Census, check to make sure that they have a valid ID badge, with their photograph, a U.S. Department of Commerce watermark, and an expiration date. Census workers may also carry Census Bureau bags and other equipment with the Census Bureau logo.

NEW ONLINE RESIDENTIAL BUILDING REGISTRATION PROGRAM

The Village of Lake Villa recently announced that their online residential building registration program is underway. Residents will no longer need to obtain permits for certain minor improvements; residents will now need to complete a building registration application online for projects such as residential re-roofing, re-siding, fences, freestanding gazebos or screen rooms, air conditioners, pergolas less than 200 sq. ft., sheds less than 200 sq. ft., water heaters and window replacements. The registration fee for these is currently \$35.00.

This new technology enhances customer service, improves communication, and reduces the amount of time that it takes for the processing of permits. Residents will still be able to apply at the Village Hall for these projects, but will also be able to apply online at www.lake-villa.org/buildingregistrations.
