A MESSAGE FROM THE MAYOR

Dear Residents,

The Lake Villa Police Department would like to advise residents about our Community Policing Program. This program is designed to promote a partnership and facilitate communication between the residents and the police department. The Lake Villa Police Department wants to provide residents with a contact within the police department that they can use for non-emergency reasons. Each subdivision is assigned a neighborhood police officer that the resident can contact. You can ask questions, report activity (speeding vehicles, graffiti, extra patrol requests, etc.), give anonymous tips reqarding criminal or suspicious behavior, or other general concerns. This program is not meant for in progress or emergency situations. Please call 9-1-1 for emergency assistance or 847-356-6106 for non-emergencies.

Below is a list of the subdivisions and the police officer assigned to that area. If you do not live in a subdivision, Sgt. Tisiani is your assigned officer. GENERAL INFORMATION

SWIMMING POOL GUIDLINES:

Chlorinated water discharged directly to surface waters (wetlands, lakes, streams, and rivers), roadways or storm sewers has an adverse impact on local water quality and wildlife. High concentrations of chlorine, as are present in swimming pools, are toxic to wildlife and fish. Appropriate preparations should be made prior to draining a pool. It is recommended that one of the following measures be used:

De-chlorinate the water in the pool prior to draining. This can be done through mechanical or chemical means. These types of products are readily available at local stores. Or, drain the pool over a period of several days across your lawn using the following additional guidelines:

- 1) Allow pool water to sit at least 2 days while receiving a reasonable amount of sunlight, and without further addition of chlorine or bromine. It is recommended that the chlorine level be tested after 2 days to ensure that safe levels are met (below 0.1 mg/l).
- 2) Pool discharge should be directed across your lawn, not down your driveway or into nearby storm sewer inlets. The storm sewer system leads directly to wetlands, streams, lakes or rivers.

These recommendations are based on guidance from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. Visit www.epa.state. il.us/water for additional information.

BRANCH PICKUP

Waste Management will be collecting branches on your normal garbage day. Branches must be bundled and tied together in no longer than four foot lengths and should not weigh more than fifty pounds. An unlimited amount of bundles may be placed at your curb for collection.

YARD WASTE STICKERS

Do you have yard waste to dispose of? Yard waste stickers are now available in the Village Hall. Stickers are \$2.22 each. Note that only cash or checks can be accepted.

Just place your yardwaste in Kraft style yardwaste bags, place the sticker on the bag, and leave at your curb. Waste Management will pick it up on your normal garbage day.

RENTAL UNIT INSPECTIONS REQUIRED

Do you rent out your home? To ensure that rental dwelling units are habitable and safe for tenants, a building and life safety inspection is required before a new tenant can occupy the rental unit. Protect yourself and others from Covid-19

The Village Hall is now open Monday - Friday, 8:30 am- 4:30 pm. The Village still encourages residents to handle as much Village business over the phone or online as possible. Those needing to access the Village Hall are required to wear a mask and social distance themselves from other's while in the Village Hall.

When visiting the Lake Villa parks and beaches, it is important that you follow the steps below to protect yourself and others from Covid-19.

Playgrounds and the skatepark are now open. No more than 50 people are permitted in a playground at one time. Stay at least 6 feet away from others you don't live with. Carefully consider use of playgrounds and associated risks, and help children follow safety guidelines. Avoid gathering with people you don't live with. Wear a face covering when feasilble. If soap and water are not readily available, frequently use hand sanitizer, especially before eating, and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing. Avoid touching face (eyes, nose, mouth) while playing.

Don't visit parks or beaches if you are sick, tested positive for Covid-19, were recently exposed within 14 days to someone with Covid-19, or just don't feel well.

Beaches at Lehmann and Glacier park are now open. Please help us keep these beaches open by following all Restore Illinois Guidelines. Limit gatherings to less than 50 people. Each large group should stay a minimum of 30 feet apart.

Parking is available at the Lehmann Park Beach for residents only. Non-residents parking is available at the Metra Station.
