WELCOME! This "Welcome Letter" is filled with pertinent information. Please read it over carefully. It should answer many of your questions. If you have questions not listed here, please call us and we will be happy to assist you.

WEBSITE: Our website is www.lake-villa.org.

HISTORY: Originally settled in the early 1800's, Lake Villa was once a resort town where the affluent and many other tourists came to relax. Several of the early mansions built here at that time still stand and are a rich part of our history. In July of 2001, the Village of Lake Villa purchased the Lehmann Mansion and 60 surrounding acres, located at 485 N. Milwaukee Avenue (Rte. 83). The Village restored the Mansion and developed the land for recreational use. The Lehmann Mansion can be rented for weddings, banquets, meetings, seminars, etc., by contacting Eddie and Mary Bauer at Party Masters Catering, 847-356-9911.

RECREATION: Lake Villa borders the Grant Woods, Sun Lake and Hastings Lake Forest Preserves, which has walking trails. We have three parks, which are open to the public however, only village residents having a current resident sticker are allowed to park within these parks. Resident stickers are available at the Village Hall. No watercraft over ten horsepower can be launched from any of our parks. The three parks are:

1. Lehmann Park, located on Cedar Avenue, provides swimming in Cedar Lake, boat launching, a picnic shelter with tables and grills, basketball court and rest rooms. It is a favorite among residents.
2. Steven Sherwood Memorial Park has a tot playground, tennis courts, volleyball, horseshoe pit, rest rooms and a shelter. The park is located on Kevin Ave.
3. Glacier Park is on Deep Lake. The entrance is off of Grand Avenue. This park has swimming and a boat launch. A gate key is required and available at the Village Hall for a small fee.
4. Frank M. Loffredo Park is located at 485 N. Milwaukee Avenue (in front of the Lehmann Mansion). The park has football, soccer, field hockey, softball and baseball fields, hockey rink and a handicap-accessible pedestrian loop with exercise stations; skateboard park, disc golf course, pavilion, restrooms and a connection to the Sun Lake Forest Preserve. *****This park is open to the public and does not require a resident sticker.**
5. Tot Lots which are maintained by the Village are located within the following subdivisions: Painted Lakes, Savanna Springs, Oakland Ridge, Cedar Ridge II and Cedar Crossings.

WATER/SEWER BILLING: Water/Sewer bills are sent out bi-monthly. Water is \$9.41 per 1,000 gallons. Sewer is \$7.32 per 1,000 gallons of water. There is an automatic sewer break in the summer months. Also, automatic payment option (Auto-Debit) is offered as well as other on-line payment options. Review these payment options by visiting our website. Effective May 01, 2018, the Village entered into a multi-year agreement with Waste Management. In place of being billed directly by Waste Management for refuse and recycling services, the bill for these services will be included on your bi-monthly Water/Sewer Utility Bill. The cost for this service is based upon the size of the refuse container. A rate of \$43.58 for a large of 96 gallon refuse container and for the smaller 64 gallon refuse container, a rate of \$37.36 will be applied to each bi-monthly utility bill.

MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE FEE: A flat fee per household is billed on the property owner's water and sewer bill. The annual fee is payable in equal installments and are as follows:

Single Family Dwelling	\$36.00 annually	Multi-family Dwelling Unit	\$18.00/unit annually
Townhouse	\$36.00 annually	Multi-family Senior Housing Unit	\$12.00/unit annually
Condominium	\$36.00 annually		

Any household with a senior member of 65 or older may apply in January for a discounted senior rate of \$12/annually. Also any household who has a member who is on active military duty is not required to pay the fee. Forms are available at the Village Hall to apply for these special rates.

TRAIN STATION: Metra service is available to Chicago and O'Hare Transfer Monday through Friday; no Saturday or Sunday Rail Service. Tickets are purchased on the train and parking is \$1.75 per day. Daily/monthly parking passes and Train Schedules are available at the Village Hall.

LEAF AND BRANCH PICKUP: Effective 5/1/18, Waste Management will provide leaf vacuuming services in the fall, typically beginning in mid-October. Do not put leaves into the street. Please do not rake branches, sticks, grass clippings, etc. into the leaf piles. Leaf burning is not permitted within the Village. Under the new branch collection program with Waste Management, branches must be bundled, no longer than four feet, with branches no thicker than four inches and cannot weigh more than 50 pounds. An unlimited amount of bundles may be placed at your curb for collection and will be picked up on your normal refuse/recycling pick up day.

GRASS CLIPPINGS AND OTHER WASTE: Waste Management will pick up grass clippings and other yard waste on your normal garbage day (April 15 – Nov. 15). Clippings and yard waste must be in a paper yard waste bag with a Waste Management sticker on them. Bags and stickers can be purchased from the Village Hall or you can contact Waste Management (847-395-2020) and subscribe to their seasonal lawn waste service.

EVENTS:

- ❖ ST. PATRICK'S DAY PARADE is held on a Saturday close to March 17th. Corned beef dinner and entertainment are available at the VFW following the parade.
- ❖ EASTER EGG HUNT is generally held the Saturday before Good Friday at Lehmann Park.
- ❖ MEMORIAL DAY PARADE is hosted by the VFW. Call 874-356-9848 for more information.
- ❖ CELEBRATION OF SUMMER – annual one day event at Lehmann Park, usually held the beginning/middle of June. Saturday is Lake Villa's answer to a mini "Ravinia". A day filled with music, open lawn picnics, raffles, the Food Court and the most spectacular fireworks display at dusk.
- ❖ LAKE VILLA PAGEANT is held in June each year. Contact the Village Hall for information/applications.
